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Royal Golf Club – Montgomerie Course Additional Local Rules

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27)

A ball is out of bounds if it comes to rest:
a) Beyond any boundary wall or fence.
b) Beyond the line of white posts to the rear of holes 5, 9, 10, 11, 14, 16 and 18.
c) Beyond the line of white posts to the left of holes 11 and 17 and to the right of holes 14 and 15 which define the BAPCO pipe-line.
d) A ball which crosses or runs through an Environmentally-Sensitive Area/Ground under Repair and comes to rest beyond that ESA/GUR.
e) Beyond the white posts and fence that define the driving range to the left of holes 10 and 18.

2. Water Hazards (Rule 26-1)

Water hazards are defined by yellow posts and lateral water hazards are defined by red posts.

3. Movable Obstructions

Stones in bunkers are to be regarded as moveable obstructions.

4. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)

a) All artificially surfaced cart paths
b) All windbreak fencing (green cloth fences).
c) Drip feed irrigation lines -

Note: Relief is available for interference to the lie of ball, area of intended swing or stance.

d) Floodlight poles -

Note: Relief is only available for physical interference to the lie of ball, area of intended swing and stance, NOT intervention on the line of play. e) All gravel areas.

5. Environmentally Sensitive Area (Rule 25-1)

The Bapco pipe lines that run parallel to holes 8, 10, 11, 12, 14, 15 & 17 are to be treated as an environmentally sensitive area. This area is defined by white posts with green tips. Players are entitled to a free drop one club length from the nearest point of relief no nearer the hole. A ball which crosses or runs through an Environmentally-Sensitive Area/Ground under Repair and comes to rest beyond that ESA/GUR is deemed OOB.
